

Pool, Spa and Hot Tub Inspection

Inspections of pools, spas and hot tubs include inspections of the pool surfaces, tiles, coping, decks, slides, steps, and diving boards. Visual inspections are made of drains, skimmers, valves, filters, gauges, pumps, blowers, motors, and the plumbing system. The electrical power supply and gas supply (if applicable) servicing the equipment and the adjacent area are inspected. Fences, gates, and access doors that lead to the area are also inspected. No equipment is dismantled, uncovered, or excavated, and therefore no subsurface leaks, water table, or defects are reported unless readily observable. Ancillary equipment, such as chlorinators, computer controls, chemical dispensers, etc., are not inspected. Electric and/or gas heaters are inspected if present.
